### **Bite Level (Dunbar Scale)**

- \_\_\_\_ Level 1 (air snap – no skin contact)
- \_\_\_\_ Level 2 (skin contact – no puncture)
- \_\_\_\_ Level 3 (1-4 punctures – no deeper than half the length of canine tooth)
- \_\_\_\_ multiple level 3 bites
- \_\_\_\_ Level 4 (1-4 punctures – at least 1 deeper than half the length of canine tooth)
- \_\_\_\_ Level 5 (multiple bites with at least 2 level 4 bites)
- \_\_\_\_ Level 6 (victim killed by dog)
